The Stanford Biomedical Physics (BMP) doctoral program was created in 2021 to train the next generation of leaders in this established and expanding field focusing on translational applications of physics and engineering in medicine. The Departments of Radiology and Radiation Oncology host faculty performing cutting edge research on topics spanning biomedical imaging hardware, image processing, radiation therapy, artificial intelligence and machine learning, and molecular imaging and diagnostics. We welcomed our first cohort of PhD students to Stanford in fall 2022 and seek applications for admission for the class of 2024. Admitted students will be fully funded by the program to pursue their PhD degrees through coursework and original research.
